**DECLARATION OF KATHERINE ROVERTONI OF A.B. DATA IN SUPPORT OF
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR FINAL APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT AND
REQUEST FOR FEES**

1 I, Katherine Rovertoni, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

2 1. I am a Project Manager at the class action notice and settlement administration division of
3 A.B. Data, Ltd. (“A.B. Data”), the Claims Administrator¹ appointed by the Court in this action. I am
4 responsible for overseeing the notice and claims process on behalf of A.B. Data for this matter. I am fully
5 familiar with the facts contained herein based upon my personal knowledge, and if called as a witness I
6 could and would competently testify to them.

7 2. The purpose of this Declaration is to provide the Court with information regarding the
8 implementation of the Court-approved Notice Plan, including the distribution of notice; administration of
9 the Settlement; receipt of exclusion requests; the filing of claims to share in the distribution of the Residual
10 Settlement Amount; and receipt of any objections to the proposed Settlement and/or Class Counsel’s
11 motion for attorneys’ fees, expenses, and service awards.

12 3. A.B. Data has been appointed as Claims Administrator and to, among other things: (a)
13 distribute notice of the Settlement to the Settlement Class Members via the methods delineated in the
14 Notice Plan and the Court’s Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Settlement, entered August 3, 2023
15 (“Preliminary Approval Order”); (b) establish and maintain a case-specific website, toll-free telephone
16 number, and email address; (c) respond to Settlement Class Member inquiries; and (d) perform all other
17 duties assigned to the Claims Administrator in the Settlement Agreement and in accordance with this
18 Court’s Preliminary Approval Order.

19 **Settlement Class List**

20 4. On or about August 23, 2023, A.B. Data received from Mueller’s counsel an Excel file
21 containing name and email information for direct purchasers from Defendant. A.B. Data performed a
22 review of the email addresses provided and removed duplicate and invalid email addresses. Additionally,
23 A.B. Data subjected all email addresses to a final email verification process by requesting each Internet
24 Service Provider (“ISP”) to confirm whether these email addresses are valid. The ISPs reported back to

1 A.B. Data as requested, allowing A.B. Data to identify undeliverable and invalid email addresses and to
2 remove them from the Email Notice campaign. This resulted in the removal of 944 duplicate or missing
3 emails and 209 invalid or unverified email addresses leaving a total of 3,452.

4 **Dissemination of the Settlement Notice**

5 **Email Notices**

6 5. Commencing on August 23, 2023 A.B. Data caused the Court-approved Email Notice to
7 be sent via email to 3,452 potential Settlement Class Members for whom we had a valid email address. A
8 true and accurate copy of the Court-approved Email Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

9 6. Of the 3,452 Email Notices sent by A.B. Data, 3,410 emails were delivered and 42 were
10 not delivered. An email was considered “delivered” if it was sent and did not bounce back as
11 undeliverable. In other words, over 98% of the emails that were sent out were successfully delivered.

12 7. In addition to the records provided as referenced above, A.B. Data is aware that
13 Amazon.com sent a notice to all potential Settlement Class Members who purchased a product from the
14 Defendant through Amazon.com. It is A.B. Data’s understanding that Amazon sent approximately
15 5,841,484 notices and that a separate declaration will be provided regarding these notice efforts for
16 Amazon directly.

17 **Publication Notice**

18 8. Beginning on August 23, 2023, and continuing for four consecutive weeks (August 23,
19 August 30, September 9, and September 13, 2023) A.B. Data caused the Court Approved Short Form
20 notice to be published in the *San Bernadino Sun* to meet the requirements of the California Consumers
21 Legal Remedies Act (“CLRA”), Civil Code §1781(d). A true and correct copy of the publication notice
22 is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

23 **Settlement Website**

24 9. On August 16, 2023, prior to the date that direct notice was provided to potential
25 Settlement Class Members, A.B. Data established the following website: www.MuellerSettlement.com
26 (the “Settlement Website”). The Settlement Website contains important Settlement deadlines; answers to

frequently asked questions; and general information about the Settlement and relevant case and Settlement documents, including the Settlement Agreement, the Long-Form Notice, and other important Court Documents. The Settlement Website also has an online claim filing portal where Settlement Class Members may submit a Claim Form.

10. The Settlement Website also has a “Contact Us” page where Settlement Class Members can contact A.B. Data via email, submit address updates, and ask questions regarding the Settlement.

11. As of January 15, 2024, the Settlement Website has received 3,641,599 website visits of which 3,540,685 were from unique visitors, resulting in a total of 8,539,303 page views.

Toll-Free Number

12. On August 23, 2023, A.B. Data established the following toll-free telephone line devoted to this Settlement that is listed in all forms of notice and on the Settlement Website: 877-933-2881. The toll-free line utilizes an interactive voice response (“IVR”) system to provide Settlement Class Members with responses to frequently asked questions and important information regarding the Settlement. The toll-free line is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. As of January 18, 2024, the toll-free hotline has received 1,176 calls totaling 757 minutes.

Settlement Class Member Claims

13. A.B. Data remains in the process of reviewing the claims received for completeness, meeting the class definition, and performing a deduplication, verification, and fraud review. Once the claims deadline has passed, the identification process is completed, and A.B. Data has verified and eliminated any fraudulent claims, A.B. Data will report to the Court on the outcome, including the number of valid verified claims to be allowed and the number of invalid claims to be disallowed.

Claim Review and Fraudulent Claims

14. After the Claims Deadline, January 30, 2024, A.B. Data’s Quality Assurance team will undertake several final audits, reviews, and fraud detection analyses including targeted reviews to uncover

1 claims potentially filed by non-humans or bots.² Bot activity in claim filing, especially as it relates to
2 class action claims where documentary evidence is not required to participate in a settlement, has risen
3 dramatically. While this phenomenon has always been present in class action claims related to cases such
4 as the instant matter, the availability of Artificial Intelligence (“AI”) has allowed bad actors to create
5 program bots to make claims that are far more difficult to detect using conventional review processes.
6 Bots are now more capable of masking, spoofing, or changing the IP address from which they are filing a
7 claim, utilizing databases of name, address, and phone number information to provide unique claimant
8 data for false claims, and programmatically obtaining thousands of valid unique email addresses making
9 identification of bot claims more challenging.

10 15. Based on an initial review of the claims submitted so far, A.B. Data estimates that more
11 than 90% of the claims submitted in the instant matter are bot claims or submissions by bad actors.
12 Consequently, A.B. Data will, prior to the Court’s hearing on Final Approval of the Class Action
13 Settlement, implement a fraud detection process whereby the claimants will be asked to complete a simple
14 final step in order to help determine whether the claim is fraudulent. This task is simple for actual class
15 members to complete but is generally not achievable by a bot. A.B. Data will then use this verification
16 process, among others, to positively identify and deny fraudulent claims.

17 **Objections and Exclusions**

18 16. As of January 18, 2024, A.B. Data has received one objection to the Settlement.

19 17. As of January 18, 2024, A.B. Data has received a total of 23 exclusion requests. A list of
20 requested exclusions is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

21 18. The deadline to postmark an objection to the Settlement Agreement or a request for
22 exclusion is January 30, 2024.

25 ² Bots are computer generated claims that are completed using a variety of techniques including IP
26 spoofing, random name, address, telephone, and email generation for the purpose of receiving multiple
27 distributions from a single settlement. Whereas bot claims are created using different information for each
28 claim, these claims cannot be tracked in a database of known fraudulent filers.

Distribution and Remaining Tasks

19. Following the Claims Deadline and completion of the claim review process, A.B. Data will establish a final valid claims list.

20. Provided the Court issues a final approval of the Settlement, and the Effective Date is achieved, A.B. Data will cause the Settlement Fund to be distributed in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and the directives and Orders of this Court.

WHAT IS THIS CASE ABOUT? In the lawsuit entitled *Stacy Dorcas v. Aterian, Inc.*, Case No. CIVSB2222117, Superior Court for the State of California, County of San Bernardino, plaintiff Stacy Dorcas ("Plaintiff" or "Class Representative"), on behalf of herself and a proposed class, alleges that Defendant falsely and deceptively labeled and advertised the Covered Products with an image of the Austrian flag and the name "Austria" (together, the "Austrian Representations"), which led reasonable consumers into believing that the Covered Products were made in Austria and paying more for the Covered Products as a result of those alleged statements, when the Covered Products were not made in Austria. A list of the Covered Products is available on the settlement website www.MuellerSettlement.com. The Court has not ruled on the merits of the claims or Aterian's defenses.

WHO IS A CLASS MEMBER? All Persons who purchased any of the Covered Products in the United States, its territories, or at any United States military facility or exchange during the Class Period are Class Members. ("Settlement Class Members").

WHAT ARE THE TERMS OF THE SETTLEMENT? Aterian has agreed to pay \$800,000 (\$500,000 in cash ("Cash Fund"), and \$300,000 in the form of Vouchers ("Voucher Fund")) into a non-reversionary Settlement Fund, as described in the Settlement. The Settlement Fund will be used to pay Settlement Class Members who send in a valid Claim Form, after attorneys' fees and costs, notice and settlement administration costs, and an incentive award to the Class Representative have been deducted.

Settlement Class Members can elect to receive a \$7.50 cash payment per Covered Product purchased during the Class Period for up to two (2) Covered Products or, in lieu of a cash payment, Settlement Class Members can elect to receive a \$15.00 Voucher per Covered Product purchased during the Class Period for up to two (2) Covered Products (subject to a *pro rata* increase or decrease as discussed). Class Counsel will ask the Court to approve payment of up to \$200,000 in attorneys' fees, to be paid from the Settlement Fund. Class Counsel also will ask the Court to approve reasonable costs and expenses spent prosecuting the case and a payment of \$1,500 to Stacy Dorcas for her services as Class Representative, to be paid from the Settlement Fund.

HOW DO I MAKE A CLAIM? To receive a Settlement Award, you must submit a signed and completed Claim Form online to the Class Action Settlement Administrator by NO LATER THAN JANUARY 30, 2024. or by mail to the Class Action Settlement Administrator postmarked NO LATER THAN JANUARY 30, 2024. WHAT ARE MY OTHER OPTIONS? If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you may opt out of the Settlement by sending a request for exclusion to the Class Action Settlement Administrator by NO LATER THAN JANUARY 30, 2024. If you opt out, you will not receive any money from the Settlement. If you stay in the Settlement, you may object to the Settlement by writing to the Court explaining why you do not like the Settlement by NO LATER THAN JANUARY 30, 2024. You will be bound by the Settlement if your objection is rejected. If you do nothing (i.e., submit no Claim Form or opt out), you will not receive any benefits from the Settlement, but will nevertheless be bound by any judgment approving the Settlement and will give up any right to sue Defendant or related parties as described in the Settlement.
